

Security of Internet Account Access BFSOnline



When registering for BFSOnline you are provided with a login ID and password, these are known as your codes. The security of your codes is very important, and you should keep both your login and your password confidential. In using BFSOnline we remind you that you agree:

- Not to use any combination or part of your date of birth, your name, family members names, or licence, social security, or similar numbers in choosing your password
- Not to record your codes in writing without making a reasonable attempt to protect their security

You must not act with extreme carelessness in failing to protect the security of all pass codes. This includes:

- Not storing your codes electronically on devices that are not password protected
- Not disclosing your password to anyone (including family members or us)
- Not allowing another person to watch you input your codes
- Not disclosing your login to anyone (except us)
- Periodically changing your password and/or login with long passwords with uppercase and lowercase letters, numbers and symbols.
- Not permitting any other person to use your codes
- Never leave your computer unattended while logged in to BFSOnline
- Examine your account statement immediately upon receiving it to identify and report, as soon as possible, any instances where electronic transactions have occurred without your authority
- Immediately notify us of any change of address
- After logging out of BFSOnline, ensuring that you close your internet browser.

Tell us as soon as you realise or suspect that another person knows one or more of your codes. You can do this by calling us on 1300 650 542 - if outside of business hours leave a message on our answering service.
